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El Nino Readiness

RSCCA has taken a proactive approach in anticipation of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's Climate Prediction Center's forecast of the the heaviest rains for the winter and spring months.

RSCCA members are encouraged to prepare for El Nino by: inspecting roofs for leaks and making repairs before the onset of rain; inspecting and cleaning out all gutters, drains, and V-Ditches to allow for adequate flow of run-off to the storm drains; and by renewing flood insurance policies.

Sandbags are available at San Clemente City Hall and at the City Yard (25 sandbags per person). City Hall is located at 100 Avenida Presidio and the City Yard is located at 390 E. Avenida Pico. City Hall's phone number: 949 361- 8200.
